A. OVERVIEW

Colleton County, South Carolina (the "**County**") requests bids from qualified vendors to provide firefighting equipment for use in the County's Fire-Rescue Department. This is a brand-specific bid. All vendors must bid on the brand requested on the bid form.

To be considered responsive, responders must use the Bid Form included in the specifications. Subject to the terms, conditions, provisions, and the enclosed specifications, responses to this solicitation will be received at this office until the stated date and time. Responses received after the scheduled due date and time will be rejected.

This solicitation does not commit Colleton County to award a contract, to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of bids submitted, or to procure or contract for the services. The County reserves the right to accept or reject or cancel in part or its entirety offers received because this request is deemed to be in the best interest of the County to do so.

Questions regarding this solicitation must be submitted via email to **Barry McRoy, Colleton County Fire Chief**, bmcroy@colletoncounty.org, no later than **11:00 am on Monday, May 15, 2023**. Answers to all questions will be posted on the County website as addendums to this bid.

B. SCOPE OF WORK

The qualified vendors shall provide the specified brand of firefighting equipment for use in the County's Fire-Rescue Department. The equipment list, manufacturer, and item number are listed on the attached bid form.

C. INSTRUCTIONS TO VENDOR

1. The submittal must include **one (1) BID** response along with a completed **W-9 form**. The individual signing the response must be an Agent legally authorized to bind the company. To be considered responsive, responders must use the Bid Form included in the specifications.
2. **All bids are due by 1:00 pm on Tuesday, May 23, 2023. Responses must be submitted via email to Kaye B. Syfrett, Procurement Manager, at ksyfrett@colletoncounty.org.**
3. It is the vendor's sole responsibility to ensure that solicitation responses, amendments thereto, or withdrawal requests are submitted by the scheduled due date and time.
4. The vendor must clearly mark as "Confidential" each part of their response, which they consider to be proprietary information that could be exempt from disclosure under Section 30-40(C) Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1976, Freedom of Information Act. Colleton County reserves the right to determine whether this information should be exempt from disclosure, and legal action may not be brought against the County or its agents for its determination in this regard.
5. **RESPONSE FORM:** All responses shall be printed in ink or typewritten. If required, additional pages may be attached. Bids written in pencil will be disqualified.
6. Subject to the terms, conditions, provisions, and the enclosed specifications, responses to this solicitation will be received via email until the stated date and time. Responses received after the due

date and time will be rejected. Bids must be submitted via email to Kaye B. Syfrett, Procurement Manager, at ksyfrett@colletoncounty.org.

7. This solicitation does not commit Colleton County to award a contract, to pay any costs incurred in the preparation of the BID submitted, or to procure or contract for the services. The County reserves the right to accept or reject or cancel in part, or in its entirety, offers received as a result of this request is deemed to be in the best interest of the County to do so.
8. All bids shall remain good for **90 days** from the date of submission.

A "No Response" qualifies as a response; however, it is the responsibility of the Vendor to notify the Procurement Office if you receive solicitations that do not apply.

D. SELECTION CRITERIA

It is the intent of Colleton County to award a contract to the lowest responsive, responsible bidder based on each item submitted on the bid form with final approval by County Council. Colleton County reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to award a most advantageous contract in the best interest of the County and its partners.

E. SPECIFIC TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. **COMPETITION:** This solicitation is intended to promote full and open competition. If any language, specifications, terms, and conditions, or any combination thereof restricts or limits the requirements in this solicitation to a single source, it shall be the responsibility of the interested vendor to notify the Procurement Office in writing no later than five (5) business days prior to the scheduled due date and time.
2. **RESPONDANTS QUALIFICATION:** The County reserves the right to request satisfactory evidence of its ability to furnish services in accordance with the terms and conditions listed herein. The County further reserves the right to make the final determination as to the Vendor's ability to provide said services.
3. **RESPONSE WITHDRAWAL:** Any responses may be withdrawn prior to the established closing date and time but not thereafter with proper approval from the Procurement Manager.
4. **REJECTION:** Colleton County reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to cancel or withdraw this solicitation, and to waive any technicality if deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
5. **WAIVER:** The County reserves the right to waive any Instruction to Vendors, General or Special Provisions, General or Special Conditions, or specifications deviation if deemed to be in the best interest of the County.
6. **RESPONSE PERIOD:** All responses shall be good for a minimum period of 90 calendar days.
7. **DEVIATIONS FROM SPECIFICATIONS:** Any deviation from specifications indicated herein must be clearly pointed out; otherwise, it will be considered that items offered are in strict compliance with these specifications, and the successful vendor will be held responsible, therefore. Deviations must be explained in detail on a separate attached sheet(s). The listing of deviations, if any, is required but will not be construed as waiving any requirements of the specifications. Unidentified deviations found during the evaluation of the response may be cause for rejection.

8. AMENDMENTS: All amendments to and interpretations of this solicitation shall be in writing and issued by the Procurement Manager of Colleton County.
9. DEBARMENT: By submitting a bid, the contractor is certifying that they are not currently debarred from responding to any request for bids by any agency or subdivision of the State of South Carolina or the United States Federal Government, nor are they an agent of any person or entity that is currently debarred from submitting bids on contracts by any agency or subdivision of the State of South Carolina or the United States Federal Government.
10. DEFAULT: In case of default by the vendor, the County reserves the right to purchase any or all items in default in the open market, charging the vendor with any excessive costs. Should such a charge be assessed, no subsequent solicitation response of the defaulting vendor will be considered in future bids until the assessed charge has been satisfied.
11. HOLD HARMLESS: All respondents to this bid shall indemnify and hold harmless Colleton County Government and any of their officers and employees from all suits and claims alleged to be a result of this request for proposals. The issuance of this request for bids constitutes only an invitation to present a bid. Colleton County reserves the right to determine, at its sole discretion, whether any aspect of a respondent's submittal meets the criteria in this request for bids. Colleton County also reserves the right to seek clarifications, to negotiate with any vendor submitting a response, to reject any or all responses with or without cause, and to modify the procurement process and schedule.
12. CANCELLATION: If this request for bids is withdrawn or the project canceled for any reason, Colleton County shall have no liability to any respondent for any costs or expenses incurred in connection with this request for bids or otherwise.
13. COLLETON COUNTY PURCHASING ORDINANCE: The Request of Bids is subject to the provisions of the Colleton County Purchasing Ordinance and any revisions thereto, which are hereby incorporated into this BID in their entirety except as amended or superseded within. This ordinance can be found at <https://www.municode.com/library/sc/colletoncounty/codes/codeofordinances> under Title 3 - Revenue and Finance.
14. FAILURE TO SUBMIT ALL MANDATORY FORMS: Failure to submit all the mandatory forms from this request for bids shall be a cause for rejection. However, Colleton County reserves the right to decide, on a case-by-case basis, in its sole discretion, whether or not to reject such a bid as non-responsive.
15. CONTRACT AWARD:
 - a. This solicitation and submitted documents, when properly accepted by Colleton County, shall constitute an agreement equally binding between the successful Vendor and the County. No oral statement of any person shall modify or otherwise change, or affect the terms, conditions, or specifications stated in the resulting agreement. The County shall not be legally bound by any amendment or interpretation that is not fully executed by both parties in writing.
 - b. The successful vendor shall be required to execute a formal agreement with the County's Procurement Office within ten (10) business days after issuance of the Notice of Award.
16. CONTRACT ADMINISTRATION: Questions or problems arising after the award of an agreement shall be directed to the Procurement Manager by calling (843) 782-0504. F. GENERAL CONTRACTUAL REQUIREMENTS

1. **ABANDONMENT OR DELAY:** If the work to be done under this contract shall be abandoned or delayed by the vendor, or if at any time the County shall be of the opinion and shall so certify in writing that work has been abandoned or delayed by the vendor, the County may annul the contract or any part thereof if the vendor fails to resolve the matter within thirty (30) days of written notice.
2. **RESPONSIBILITY:** The vendor shall at all times observe and comply with all federal, state, local, and municipal laws, ordinances, rules, and regulations in any manner affecting the contract.
3. **NON-APPROPRIATION/SUBSTITUTION PERMITTED:** If the Colleton County Council fails to appropriate or authorize the expenditure of sufficient funds to provide the continuation of this contract or if a lawful order issued in, or for any fiscal year during the term of the agreement, reduces the funds appropriated or authorized in such amounts as to preclude making the payments set out therein, the agreement shall terminate on the date said funds are no longer available without any termination charges or other liability incurring to County. Following any such non-appropriation, the master lease agreement shall contain no limitation on the County's ability to replace the equipment financed with any other equipment.
4. **INDEMNIFICATION:** Except for expenses or liabilities arising from the negligence of the County, the vendor hereby expressly agrees to indemnify and hold the County harmless against any and all expenses and liabilities arising out of the performance or default of any resulting agreement or arising from or related to the Work as follows:

The Vendor expressly agrees to the extent that there is a causal relationship between its negligence, action, or inaction, or the negligence, action, or inaction of any of its employees or any person, firm, or corporation directly or indirectly employed by the vendor, and any damage, liability, injury, loss or expense (whether in connection with bodily injury or death or property damage or loss) that is suffered by the County and its employees or by any member of the public, to indemnify and save the County and its employees harmless against any and all liabilities, penalties, demands, claims, lawsuits, losses, damages, costs, and expenses arising out of the performance or default of any resulting agreement or arising from or related to the equipment. Such costs are to include defense, settlement, and reasonable attorneys' fees incurred by the County and its employees. This promise to indemnify shall include bodily injuries or death occurring to the vendor's employees and any person, directly or indirectly employed by the vendor, the County's employees, or occurring to any member of the public. When the County submits notice, the vendor shall promptly defend any aforementioned action.

The prescribed limits of insurance set forth herein shall not limit the extent of the Vendor's responsibility under this Section. The terms and conditions contained in this Section shall survive the termination of any resulting agreement or the suspension of the work hereunder. Additionally, the County will not provide indemnity to the successful VENDOR. Failure to comply with this section may result in your request for bids to be deemed non-responsive.

5. **FORCE MAJEURE:** The vendor shall not be liable for any excess costs if the failure to perform the resulting agreement arises out of causes beyond the control and without fault or negligence of the vendor. Such causes may include, but are not restricted to, acts of God or of the public enemy, acts of the Government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, fires, floods, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, strikes, freight embargoes, and unusually severe weather; but in every case the failure to

perform must be beyond the control and without the fault or negligence of the vendor. If the failure to perform is caused by default of a supplier, and if such default arises out of causes beyond the control of both the vendor and supplier and without excess costs for failure to perform, unless the supplies or services to be furnished by the supplier were obtainable from other sources in sufficient time to permit the vendor to meet the required delivery schedule.

6. **ARBITRATION:** Under no circumstances and with no exception will Colleton County act as arbitrator between the vendor and any supplier.
7. **PUBLICITY RELEASES:** The vendor agrees not to refer to the award of this contract in commercial advertising in such a manner as to state or imply that the products or services provided are endorsed or preferred by the County. The vendor shall not have the right to include the County's name in its published list of customers without prior approval of the County Administrator. With regard to news releases, only the name of the County, type, and duration of any resulting agreement may be used and then only with prior approval of the County. The vendor also agrees not to publish, or cite in any form, any comments or quotes from the County's staff unless it is a direct quote from the Procurement Manager.
8. **GOVERNING LAWS:** Any agreement arising from this solicitation shall be governed by the laws of the State of South Carolina, and any and all disputes arising out of said agreement shall, if litigation is necessary, be litigated only in a Circuit Court for the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit sitting in Colleton County, South Carolina. The prevailing party shall be entitled to attorney's fees and all costs of said litigation.
9. **ASSIGNMENT:** The vendor shall not assign in whole or in part any agreement resulting from this Request for Bids without the prior written consent of the County. The vendor shall not assign any money due or to become due to him under the said agreement without the prior written consent of the County.
10. **AFFIRMATIVE ACTION:** The successful vendor will take affirmative action in complying with all Federal and State requirements concerning fair employment and treatment of all employees, without regard or discrimination by reason of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, or physical handicap.
11. **FAILURE TO DELIVER GOODS IN ACCORDANCE WITH TERMS & CONDITIONS:** In case of failure to deliver goods in accordance with the contract terms and conditions, Colleton County, after due oral or written notice, may procure substitute goods or services from other sources and hold the vendor responsible for any resulting additional purchasing and administrative costs. This remedy shall be in addition to any other remedies which Colleton County may have.
12. **TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:**
 1. Subject to the Provisions below, the contract may be terminated by the Purchasing Department providing a thirty (30) days advance notice in writing is given to the contractor.
 - a. **Termination for Convenience:** In the event that this contract is terminated or canceled upon request and for the convenience of the County without the required thirty (30) days advance written notice, then the County shall negotiate reasonable termination costs, if applicable.
 - b. **Termination for Cause:** Termination by the County for cause, default, or negligence on the part of the vendor shall be excluded from the foregoing provisions; termination costs, if any, shall not apply. The thirty (30) days advance notice requirement is waived, and the default provision in this request for proposals shall apply.
 - c. The County shall be obligated to reimburse the vendor only for those services rendered prior to the date of notice of termination, less any liquidation damages that may be assessed for non-performance.

2. Non-Appropriations Clause: Notwithstanding any other provisions of the contract, if the funds anticipated for the continued fulfillment of this contract are at any time. Not forthcoming, through the failure of the County Government to appropriate funds, discontinuance or material alteration of the program under which funds were provided, the County shall have the right to terminate the contract without penalty by giving not less than thirty (30) days written notice documenting the lack of funding. Unless otherwise agreed to by the County and the Vendor, the contract shall become null and void on the last day of the fiscal year for which appropriations were received.
13. GOVERNING LAWS: Any contract resulting from this request for bids shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the State of South Carolina, and any litigation with respect thereto shall be brought in the courts of the State of South Carolina.
14. BONDS: Payment and Performance Bonds are not required for this request for bids.
15. OWNERSHIP OF MATERIAL: Ownership of all data, material, and documentation originated and prepared for the County pursuant to this contract shall belong exclusively to the County.
16. TYPE OF CONTRACT: This contract is a unit price contract.
17. INSURANCE: Colleton County will require the following to remain in force at all times through the life of the contract:

Workers' Compensation - \$100,000 – for each accident

Statutory Coverage and Employer - \$100,000 for each employee

Liability - \$500,000 – policy limit

Comprehensive General Liability - \$1,000,000 – bodily injury each occurrence

\$1,000,000 – bodily injury aggregate

\$1,000,000 – property damage each occurrence

\$1,000,000 – property damage aggregate

Products-Completed Operations - \$1,000,000 – aggregate

Business Auto Liability – Same as Comprehensive General Liability

Excess or Umbrella Liability - \$1,000,000

Colleton County will be named as an "additional insured"
