**RESOLUTION NO. 17-R-73**

**COUNCIL-ADMINISTRATOR FORM OF GOVERNMENT FOR COLLETON COUNTY**

**[A Resolution to Authorize the Purchase of an Electronic Ticketing Solution for the Sheriff's Office.]**

**WHEREAS:**

1. Section 56-7-30 of the South Carolina State Code, which was effective January 1, 2017 requires that all public safety organizations have the ability to transmit tickets electronically by January 1, 2018; and
2. The Technology department solicited quotations from various companies which provide an electronic ticketing solution; and
3. Four vendors submitted quotes for an electronic ticketing solution, and CDW Government, Inc. had the lowest bid at \$156,889.27 including tax; and
4. This item was budgeted in the General Fund – Fund 100 Technology Budget for FY 2018.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COLLETON COUNTY COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:**

1. The purchase of the electronic ticketing solution from CDW Government, Inc. is hereby authorized at a cost of \$156,889.27.
