**This amendment is effective as of March 13, 2009.**

Sealed Bid RC-09 must be further revised and amended and will now read as follows, in part:

a) On Page 5 of the original bid document, the second bullet point “Level the area...” will be deleted and the following specifications will be inserted in its place:

*Level the area with a finished grade of 1% with a slope towards the tree line.*

b) On the top of Page 5 of the original bid document, an additional bullet will be added to the Scope of Work:

- *Top Soil must be left on site*

c) On Page 5 of the original bid document, Court specifications will be revised and will now read as follows:

- COURT (1):**      **Pricing should be given for either or both of the following options:**
- **Pave with type 4 asphalt compacted to a minimum of 1 ½” with a 6” base in accordance with industry codes and standards.**
  - **Pave with concrete – 4” thick, 3000 psi with fiber with a smooth finish**
    - **Curing: Protect curing concrete with approved methods. *Acid wash as necessary in order for paint used in court striping to adhere to the concrete.***
    - **Provide scoring of the concrete surface, ½” deep cuts with diamond saw blade to assist in controlling cracking of the concrete.**
    - **Provide scoring cuts at approximately 15’-6” from end to end of concrete slab along the length and width of the slab.**
    - *Include a turn down of 1 foot wide and 8” deep around the entire court area.*

This amendment will not require any alterations to the time of the original bid closing and opening; therefore, bids will still be accepted until 1:00 PM, Wednesday, March 18, 2009.
