[A Resolution to Authorize the Waiver of Solid Waste Residential Debris Disposal Fees.]


WHEREAS:

1. To assist in the debris removal from the wind storm on Monday, January 3, 2022, Colleton County Council wishes to enact emergency procedures to waive its residential debris disposal fees at the Colleton County Solid Waste construction and debris landfill on Green Pond Highway through Monday, January 10, 2022; and
2. Effective immediately, the primary Colleton County Solid Waste Facility on Green Pond Highway will be open during regular hours to accept storm debris. Colleton County collection sites and the landfill will be open as scheduled for all other refuse.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COLLETON COUNTY COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:
