**[A Resolution to Amend the Colleton County Personnel Policy Manual, Section 11.4 – Holidays to Remove Confederate Memorial Day and Replace it with Good Friday.]**

**WHEREAS:**

1. County Council has received concern from the public regarding the County’s holiday schedule; and
2. Council requested that staff poll the other counties in South Carolina for their holiday schedules; and
3. The majority of counties take Good Friday rather than Confederate Memorial Day; and
4. Council hereby deems it to be in the best interest of the County to remove Confederate Memorial Day as a County holiday and replace it with Good Friday.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COLLETON COUNTY COUNCIL DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:**

1. Section 11.4 Holidays of Colleton County Personnel Policy is hereby amended by the addition of the following:
  - a. Removing Confederate Memorial Day as a County holiday and replacing it with Good Friday.
