

## **Emergency Pets Equipment Checklist:**

Assemble a portable Pet Disaster Supply kit. Whether you are away from home for a day or a week, you'll need essential supplies. Keep items in an accessible place and store them in sturdy containers that can be carried easily. Your pet disaster supplies kit should include ---

- **Sky Kennel / Crate**
- **Leash, Collar, ID Tag, Harness**
- **Food and Water Bowls**
- **Health Records**
- **( Rabies Certificate )**
- **Photos Of Pet**
- **Newspaper (dog)**
- **litter Box/Litter (cat)**
- **3 Bath Towels**
- **Garbage Bags**
- **Water (Dog: 1 Gal/10 Pounds)**
- **Cats ½ Gal**
- **Dry Food**
- **( ½ Pound Of Food / 10 Pounds)**
- **Medication**

### **Suggestions for the storage of Equipment**

- 1. Place the sky kennel together as a trial, Store and transport it disassembled.**
- 2. Use a towel to partially cover the kennel during the height of the storm for added security.**
- 3. Allow your pet to become familiar with the kennel at home and before a disaster.**
- 4. Grocery store plastic bags make excellent pooper-scoopers.**
- 5. Avoid excess bedding, as it may become soiled and difficult to clean during a disaster.**
- 6. A chain and stake may be useful to secure a dog if the family must use a temporary shelter.**
- 7. Dry pet food is much easier to transport and use than canned food during temporary shelter.**
