## ADDENDUM 1 DATED: JANUARY 13, 2021

The following questions have been submitted for clarification:

What is the estimated value of this project?
 Answer: There is no estimated project value.

2. What is the start date for this project?

Answer: The start date is contingent on the bid process and award criteria. See section E-6 for time line of bids to remain good.

3. Will there be liquidated damages?

Answer: Yes. The parties recognize the delays, expense, and difficulties involved in proving in a legal or arbitration proceeding the actual loss suffered by Owner if the Work is not completed on time. Accordingly, instead of requiring any such proof, Owner and Contractor agree that as liquidated damages for delay (but not as a penalty), Contractor shall pay Owner \$500 for each day that expires after the time specified for completion and readiness for final payment until the Work is completed and ready for final payment. Liquidated damages can and will be assessed against the final payment request and any retainage held by Colleton County. Should funding for Liquidated damages exceed the amount held by Colleton County in the form of Payments or Retainage, work shall stop until such time as the Liquidated Damages issue is resolved.

4. Is a bid bond required and if so what percentage?

Answer: Yes. A Bid must be accompanied by Bid security made payable to Colleton County in an amount of five percent (5%) of Bidder's maximum Bid price and in the form of a certified check, bank money order, or a Bid Bond issued by a surety.

5. On page 13, the "Debarment" form has a blank for the Sam's No. However, after speaking with the Federal Service Desk, I am told there is no such thing as a SAM's No., only a Cage Code and DUN's No. Would you please confirm the SAM's No. is not needed?

Answer: No. A SAM's number is not needed. Attached is a revised Debarment form that must be completed and submitted as part of your bid.
