

EFFECTIVE MARCH 30, 2020


BY ORDER OF THE GOVERNOR, ALL PUBLIC PIERS, DOCKS, WHARFS, BOAT RAMPS, AND BOAT LANDINGS PROVIDING PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE PUBLIC WATERS OF THIS STATE, TO INCLUDE ANY ADJACENT OR ASSOCIATED PUBLIC PARKING LOTS OR OTHER PUBLIC FACILITIES, SHALL BE CLOSED TO PUBLIC ACCESS FOR RECREATIONAL PURPOSES FOR THE DURATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY. THE BEACHING OR RAFTING OF BOATS, WHETHER ON A SANDBAR, LAKESHORE, RIVERBANK, OR ISLAND, IS PROHIBITED FOR THE DURATION OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY. VESSELS MUST REMAIN UNDERWAY AT ALL TIMES UNLESS EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES EXIST. ANCHORING TO FISH IS ALLOWED; HOWEVER, RAFTING IS PROHIBITED UNDER ALL CIRCUMSTANCES. THIS ORDER NOT APPLY TO INDIVIDUALS POSSESSING A CURRENT, VALID COMMERCIAL FISHING LICENSE OR PERMIT TO THE EXTENT SUCH INDIVIDUALS MAY SEEK TO UTILIZE OR RELY UPON PUBLIC PIERS, DOCKS, WHARFS, BOAT RAMPS, OR BOAT LANDINGS IN CONNECTION WITH COMMERCIAL FISHING ACTIVITIES.
